Ridgeley is quoted saying, "As a breast cancer survivor and mother of two teenage daughters, I'm committed to ending this disease. Pink ribbons are great for raising awareness, but it's time to find ways to stop breast cancer before it starts. I believe the deep, innovative research of Dr. Susan Love Foundation for Breast Cancer Research is bringing us closer to that goal."
