The Dr. Susan Love Foundation for Breast Cancer Research is currently accepting research abstract submissions for participation in the 11<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on the Breast.

### General Information

The Symposium gathers world-class researchers, clinicians, and advocates from multiple disciplines in an intimate think-tank environment to stimulate ideas, collaboration, seed-funding opportunities, and ultimately breakthroughs that will end breast cancer. The Foundation will be awarding travel scholarships for researchers with accepted abstracts in various amounts dependent on their country of origin. All speakers will be offered reimbursement for expenses related to the Symposium. Domestic speakers will be reimbursed up to \$850 and international speakers up to \$1,250.

### Application Process

All applicants will be notified either by mail, telephone, or email by December 31, 2022. ## ABSTRACT

1000-2000 words. The text of the abstract must contain the title (*bold, all caps*), complete names of authors (*bold, initials caps*), affiliations (initial caps, unbolded), and the primary author's e-mail address, followed by the single-spaced abstract. (Do not type the text of the abstract in all capitals. Do not exceed the form's margins. Place figures and tables within the text. Legends should be beneath the figures or tables.) In the text, begin single-space typing one line below the top line. Skip one line between paragraphs. Paragraphs should be flush to the left-hand margin. Abbreviations may be used in the text of the abstract if they are defined at their first mention in the text. Do not exceed one page.

**The abstract will appear in the proceedings exactly as submitted.**
